

THE CORPORATION OF THE VILLAGE OF ST. CLAIR BEACH

BY-LAW NUMBER 734

A By-law to regulate and govern the operation of motorized snow vehicles in the Village.

WHEREAS The Motorized Snow Vehicles Act, 1968, provides that the Council of a local municipality may pass by-laws regulating, governing or prohibiting the operation of motorized snow vehicles within the municipality including any highways therein or any part or parts thereof;

AND WHEREAS Council of the Corporation of the Village of St. Clair Beach deems it expedient and desirable to enact a by-law to regulate and govern the operation of motorized snow vehicles within the municipality.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Village of St. Clair Beach hereby enacts as follows:-

1. In this By-law:

(a) "highway"

shall mean a highway as defined in The Highway Traffic Act;

(b) "motorized snow vehicle" shall mean a self-propelled vehicle designed to be driven exclusively on snow or ice or both.

2. No motorized snow vehicle shall be operated on any private property in the municipality unless the operator of such a vehicle has obtained the prior permission of the owner or occupant of the property.

3. No motorized snow vehicle shall be operated within the boundaries of the Village's public park known as Green Acres Park.

4. No person shall operate any motorized snow vehicle in the Village of St. Clair Beach between the hours of:

- (a) 11:00 P.M. Sunday and 8:00 A.M. Monday;
- (b) 11:00 P.M. Monday and 8:00 A.M. Tuesday;
- (c) 11:00 P.M. Tuesday and 8:00 A.M. Wednesday;
- (d) 11:00 P.M. Wednesday and 8:00 A.M. Thursday;
- (e) 11:00 P.M. Thursday and 8:00 A.M. Friday;
- (f) 12:00 P.M. Friday and 8:00 A.M. Saturday;
- (g) 12:00 P.M. Saturday and 8:00 A.M. Sunday.


5. The operation of a motorized snow vehicle, along any highway under the jurisdiction of the Council of the Village of St. Clair Beach, shall be restricted to the right of the centre of the roadway of each such highway.

6. The owner and/or driver of every motorized snow vehicle who contravenes any of the provisions of this By-law; The Motorized Snow Vehicles Act, 1968 or the regulations made thereunder, are guilty of an offence and on summary conviction are liable to a fine of not less than \$20.00 and not more than \$100.00.

7. That By-law Number 729 be and the same is hereby repealed in its entirety.

READ a first, second and third time and finally passed this 18th day of January, 1971.

BY-LAW NUMBER 735

To provide a partial exemption on farm lands from general taxation.

WHEREAS The Assessment Act, 1968-69, Section 29, Subsection (1), provides for a partial exemption on farm lands from taxation for certain expenditures, where lands held and used as farm lands only, and in blocks of not less than five acres.

AND WHEREAS The Council of the Corporation of the Village of St. Clair Beach deems it expedient to grant a partial exemption from taxation on such farm lands.

NOW THEREFORE The Council of the Corporation of the Village of St. Clair Beach enacts as follows:

That an exemption equivalent to a reduction of 10% of the general tax rate be allowed on the following farm lands, on the 1971 Collector's Roll:
