

THE CORPORATION OF THE
VILLAGE OF ST. CLAIR BEACH

By-law No. 2072

Being a by-law to provide for the election of a Deputy Mayor.

Whereas Bill Pr108, Chapter Pr 27, Statutes of Ontario, 1994, provides for the election by general vote of one of its members to be named deputy mayor;

And Whereas the Municipal Council, of the Village of St. Clair Beach, deems it desirable to pass a by-law pursuant to said Bill Pr108 to provide for the position of a deputy mayor and to determine the duties of such deputy mayor.

Now Therefore the Municipal Council, of the Corporation of the Village of St. Clair Beach does hereby enact as follows :

1. That commencing with the year 1994, one member of the Municipal Council, of the Village of St. Clair Beach, shall be named "Deputy Mayor" and shall be elected by general vote pursuant to The Municipal Elections Act.
2. The Deputy Mayor shall be given such duties as may be determined by the Municipal Council of the Village of St. Clair Beach, passed pursuant to Procedural By-law Number 1040 or as may be amended or replaced from time to time.
3. This by-law shall remain in full force and effect until repealed in accordance with the provisions of said Bill Pr108.
4. This by-law shall become effective upon the final passing thereof.
