

**THE CORPORATION OF THE  
VILLAGE OF ST. CLAIR BEACH**

**By-law No. 2077**

**Being a By-law to amend By-Law No. 2062  
respecting Education Rates**

**Whereas** ON 1994 06 02, the Municipal Council, of the Corporation of the Village of St. Clair Beach did enact its By-law Number 2062, being a by-law to adopt and authorize the levying of rates for county and education purposes, for the year 1994;

**And Whereas** it is deemed necessary and expedient to amend said By-law Number 2062 to address palpable errors discerned therein;

**Now Therefore** the Municipal Council, of the Corporation of the Village of St. Clair Beach does hereby enact as follows :

1. Paragraph 5. on Page 2 of By-law Number 2062 is hereby repealed in its entirety and substituted with the following :

"5. That the rate of 164.552 Mills on the dollar be levied on the Public School Residential Assessment and the rate of 193.591 Mills on the dollar be levied on the Public School Commercial Assessment of rateable property in the Village of St. Clair Beach to raise the sum of \$527,748.00 for Secondary Public School purposes for the year 1994."

2. Paragraph 6. on Page 2 of By-law Number 2062 is hereby repealed in its entirety and substituted with the following :

"6. That the rate of 170.738 Mills on the dollar be levied on the Separate School Residential Assessment and the rate of 200.869 Mills on the dollar be levied on the Separate School Commercial Assessment of rateable property in the Village of St. Clair Beach to raise the sum of \$549,577.00 for Secondary Separate School purposes for the year 1994."


3. The 1994 Collector's Roll for the purpose of levying rates for Secondary Public and Secondary Separate School purposes upon Commercial Assessments be ratified and confirmed notwithstanding these amendments for housekeeping purposes only.

4. That this by-law be deemed effective as at 1994 06 02.

**Read** a first, second, third time and finally passed this 1994 09 12.
